

## **Available Position: Director of Employer Partnerships and Engagement**

The **Director of Employer Partnerships and Engagement** is a key, visible, leadership position within the organization. The suitable candidate will be responsible for identifying, cultivating, and engaging with employers, business leaders, and business intermediary organizations *in a structural rather than transactional manner* in order to accelerate and advance JobsFirstNYC's major initiatives. The suitable candidate for this role will provide strategic, forward-looking/thinking cultivation and management of employer partnerships, constituent engagement, and program and practice management, with a dual focus on expanding employer engagement and ensuring the enhancement of business management practices over time. The overall performance standard for this position is the direct evidence of employer involvement – and the measurable impact of this involvement – in all of JobsFirstNYC's programming and in service of its overarching institutional agenda. The optimal candidate will bring a rich array of resources and connections to the role, and will be able to readily leverage these, in addition to JobsFirstNYC's strong connections, in order to build and strengthen a strong employer base for our work.

### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### **Employer Engagement**

- Engage and cultivate key business leadership in the New York City economy in order to secure and mobilize young adult champions that will support and advance JobsFirstNYC's mission.
- Develop and implement long- and short-term goals to expand and continually improve employer engagement over time, and measure the efficacy of this engagement in terms of impact on programs.
- Stay abreast of market-demand trends, changes in various sectors/industries, and aggregate and share information relevant to inform in-demand skills and education training.
- Identify and disseminate scalable ways to deliver programming for training and career-related development and services, and serve as a connector and accelerant of programming through employer connections.
- Work with the JobsFirstNYC's Employer Leadership Council to identify, target, and initiate population-relevant employer relationships at the local, regional, and national level. Identify employer needs on the Council and work with targeted members to fill those needs over time.
- Develop strategic engagement activities targeted at tapping the skills and interest of the Employer Leadership Council, engaging employers by sectors/industries, and increasing meaningful interaction between employers and practitioners.
- Develop and strengthen ties between our Employer Leadership Council and the full array of current JobsFirstNYC projects.
- Raise awareness about JobsFirstNYC's effective and innovative strategies to improve engagement of young adults through the workforce development system.

#### **Partner and Constituent Engagement**

- Develop partnerships and collaborate with local labor unions, employer associations, Chambers of Commerce and other employer-driven groups to leverage resources and strengthen the organization's presence amongst employers.

- Develop, oversee and facilitate constituent activities including the Job Developers Networking Events, Community-Based, Demand-Driven: *Strategies for Building Next Generation Programs* convenings, youth engagement council and other constituent convenings, among others.
- Provide technical assistance around engaging employers and employment placements to projects and programs supported by the organization.

### **Product Development**

- Draft original papers; write opinion pieces for the media, and JobsFirstNYC's newsletter and blog.
- Co-lead and coordinate the development and production of reports and other organizational written material; work with staff and consultants to complete and issue a range of publications and products.
- Seek and foster new opportunities for product development.

### **Projects and Program**

- Work on a wide array of projects and program initiatives.
- Assist with technical assistance deliverables and track outcomes for projects/programs.
- Compile and report statistical employment data on all projects.

### **Other**

- Assist with other organizational work around raising consciousness, identifying and lifting up effective practices, and employer engagement.
- Represent the organization in local, regional and national professional associations by serving on committees and presenting at conferences.
- Some local and national travel; flexible hours periodically to meet responsibilities.

### **Qualifications**

- Minimum of a BA, MA in a relevant discipline preferred.
- Ten years of professional experience in employer cultivation engagement to include corporate recruiting, human resources, and career development.
- Strong knowledge of the New York City workforce development system – notably as it pertains to young adult employment training.
- Exemplary written and verbal communications skills, and relationship management skills.
- Contemporary knowledge of career trends, market demand, internships, and similar experiential programs; employer relations and cultivation.
- Private sector/business leadership experience preferred.
- Well-organized, with excellent follow-through ability.
- Ability to manage multiple tasks and competing priorities.
- Keen proficiency in Microsoft Office and social media applications.
